

University of Yamanashi
Graduate School of Medicine Special Scholarship
Application Guidelines for 2020

The University of Yamanashi (UY) offers the Special Scholarship for privately funded international students enrolling in a doctoral course of the Graduate School of Medicine at UY (hereafter the “Special Scholarship”). The purpose of the Special Scholarship is to reduce the financial burden on privately funded international students.

1. Qualifications and eligibility requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following eligibility requirements.

- (1) Those who wish to enroll in a doctoral course of the Graduate School of Medicine of UY starting in April 2020.
- (2) Those who have been admitted for enrollment by an academic advisor in charge of the doctoral course of the Graduate School of Medicine at UY.
- (3) Those who stand in need of financial support.

2. Scholarship amount

- (1) Scholarship: 60,000 JPY per month

※ If a recipient of the Special Scholarship is to receive an external scholarship of more than ¥80,000 per month, the amount in excess of ¥80,000 will be deducted from the recipient’s Special Scholarship amount.

- (2) Single sum: an amount equivalent to the admission fee paid by the recipient.

3. Scholarship duration

The scholarship duration is from the month of enrollment to the month of completion of the doctoral course, provided that it shall not exceed the standard completion years.

4. Application documents

All of the following documents must be submitted.

- ① Special Scholarship Application Form

- ② Transcript

※ All complete or incomplete undergraduate and postgraduate tertiary transcripts

- ③ Letter of recommendation from current or most recent academic advisor

5. Selection and results notification

Recipients are decided by the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine through selection by the International Exchange Committee of the Faculty of Medicine. Successful applicants will receive the notification of selection results together with documents for matriculation.

6. Others

(1) The Special Scholarship payments will be temporarily suspended if:

- ① the recipient repeats a year;
- ② the recipient transfers to another institution; or
- ③ the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine considers it inappropriate to grant the scholarship.

(2) The Special Scholarship payments will be terminated if:

- ① the recipient loses the status of doctoral student at UY;
- ② the recipient causes significant damage to UY's credibility; or
- ③ the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine considers it inappropriate to grant the scholarship.

(3) The Special Scholarship does not require repayment. However, the recipient must reimburse in part or full if the scholarship is terminated by ② or ③ of the preceding paragraph.
